Yr level	Content	Assessment
Prep	This term in Visual Arts, we will be exploring illustrations in books and identifying how line , shape and colour enhance images and help tell a story. Students will use a variety of materials and artistic techniques to create their own artworks.	While there is no formal assessment for this term, students will be monitored for participation and engagement when applying new skills and understandings.
Year 1	This term in Visual Arts, we will be exploring both real and imagined places, and what <i>place</i> can mean to different people. Using a variety of materials and artistic techniques, we will create artworks that focus on three key elements of art: line , shape , and colour . We will also discover how artists use these elements to tell stories and share their ideas through their artwork.	This term students will make a collection of work focusing on using line, shape and colour to create real and imagined places. Students will also be assessed on responding to artworks and identifying where and why artworks are made and presented.
